- D5. A single image (any medium) inspired by Delapré Abbey, its history or surrounding. Displayed on a table stand. No bigger than A3.

PRESERVES

- D6. A jar of soft jam or jelly
- D7. A jar of chutney
- D8. Best innovative flavour (each to be arranged next to a plain plate with table spoonful already displayed)

Any single image of Delapré Abbey - painting, photo, collage etc. No bigger than A4 and to be displayed on a table easel:

1. Entry in any class is open to all visitors to Delapré Abbey Village Show.
2. Only one exhibit per class per person is permitted.
3. Entry forms together with the fee of £1 per entry (children's classes free) may be handed in at the Visitor Welcome at Delapré Abbey any time before the day of the show or alternatively on the 8th September between 9am and 10.15am (cash only). Further forms can be obtained from Delapré Abbey or downloaded from our website www.delapreabbey.org. Alternatively they can be obtained from Elsie's Café, Market Street Community Room, Brunswick Place, Northampton NN1 4BG. Email enquiries can be sent to info@delapreabbey.org.
4. Exhibits to be delivered to the South Lawn marquee and arranged on the morning of the show between 9am and 10.15am.
5. All entries must meet the class description with regards to numbers, weights or other sizes.
5. Judging will start promptly at 11am. Result cards and rosettes will be posted and the marquee will open at 12noon.
6. No exhibits must be removed before 4.30pm. Please indicate on the entry form if entry can be included in the auction (drawn after presentations at 4.30pm) with proceeds going to Delapré Abbey Preservation Trust / Northampton Flower and Produce Show.
7. All exhibits in the vegetable and flower classes must have been grown by the exhibitor, all entries in the cake and preserve classes should have been made by the exhibitor, and all children's entries should be made by the exhibitor.
8. Any decision or award by the judges will be final. NB: Judges in children's section will take age into consideration in sections. Children up to / including the age of 18.
9. Participants agree to photographs of items and winners' names being published on websites and social media.
10. Delapré Abbey Preservation Trust and Fruitful Abundance reserve the right to change, alter, suspend, cancel and to declare void any aspects of the show at any time.
